
DIY Organizer

FOR CLOTH DIAPER STORAGE



MATERIALS

- Two 1x6 boards (10-ft each). I used white pine.
- Sandpaper, 150-grit or 220-grit
- Nail gun with nails
- Stain or paint of your choice
- Polycryclic
- 2 L-brackets with screws

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Sand your boards using 150-grit or 220-grit sandpaper until smooth. This will prevent damage to your diapers (and your hands!).
- 2. Cut one 10-ft board to three 35-inch pieces.
- 3. Cut the other 10-ft board into 12, 9-inch pieces. Use a 22.5 degree angle when you cut.
- 4. Stain or paint your boards the color of your choice. This will be so much easier than trying to paint or stain after it's put together.
- 5. Use polycrylic to seal your boards.
- 6. Arrange the pieces as shown below. The shelf pieces (shown in gray) will fit insidethe vertical pieces (shown in green). Secure together using a nail gun.
- 7. Once it's complete, secure to your wall with one L-bracket at the top and one at the bottom.

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
