

DIY Organizer

FOR CLOTH DIAPER STORAGE

MATERIALS

- Two 1x6 boards (10-ft each). I used white pine.
- Sandpaper, 150-grit or 220-grit
- Nail gun with nails
- Stain or paint of your choice
- Polycrylic
- 2 L-brackets with screws

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Sand your boards using 150-grit or 220-grit sandpaper until smooth. This will prevent damage to your diapers (and your hands!).
2. Cut one 10-ft board to three 35-inch pieces.
3. Cut the other 10-ft board into 12, 9-inch pieces. Use a 22.5 degree angle when you cut.
4. Stain or paint your boards the color of your choice. This will be so much easier than trying to paint or stain after it's put together.
5. Use polycrylic to seal your boards.
6. Arrange the pieces as shown below. The shelf pieces (shown in gray) will fit inside the vertical pieces (shown in green). Secure together using a nail gun.
7. Once it's complete, secure to your wall with one L-bracket at the top and one at the bottom.



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
